Dear Ken:

On behalf of the Miramichi Cross Country Ski Club (M.C.C.S.C.) I would like to inquire as to the possibility of the company donating a section of camps from Operation # 5 to our club to be used as a club house for the upcoming season.

We would require a building approximately 20 ft. x 48 ft. in order for it to adequately meet our requirements as a club house. I believe the section used for the offices at Operation # 5 would be roughly that size. Last year the M.C.C.S.C. used the camp at the Nordin rifle range for its club house, unfortunately it burned during the past year and was not rebuilt. However, the club has been given a lot of land in Nordin for its use and on which we would place the building.

If a donation of this type is not possible, then we would appreciate the opportunity to purchase the camp from the company. This would eliminate the chance that the club may lose out through bidding.

As the M.C.C.S.C. is a non profit community organization and offers winter recreation to all people of the community, we would greatly appreciate any help the company may be able to give us in order that we may acquire a club house.
