TRAILS:

The trail system has been expanded this year to include approximately two (2) kilometers from the McKinnon Road north to the hydro line. The addition of this trail completes a loop about 8.5 Km from the clubhouse to the hydro line and return. All bridges in the trail system have been or will be upgraded, particularly that one common to the N100 and trail #8.

Negotiations are presently underway to have our trails groomed on a daily basis with the highest priority being given to the 5 Km racing loop in Nordin, the #8 and #2 trails and the trails around the clubhouse. All trails will be trackset for the weekend traffic. This is a large task for only a few individuals, so if you are interested in helping to maintain our trail system as one of the best in the province please indicate ~~your~~ willingness to participate to one of the Executive.

The marking of our trails will continue to improve this year and our intention is to locate maps of the trail system at strategic intersections.

We hope to improve our relations with snowmobilers in order that our mutual use of trails will not interfere with one another. Your involvement in this educational endeavour is essential for our success.
