- * Employee - Vincent Driscoll
- * Hours of work - 10 a.m. - 6 p.m.
 - Wednesday to Sunday
 - Hours and days may change depending on club activities and weather conditions
- * Trails
 - to groom and set track as required
 - to cut, thin, trim trees and bushes as required
 - to keep a daily log of work completed
 - to complete other trail work as assigned
- * Clubhouse
 - to open and close clubhouse each working day
 - to start a fire in club stove each morning
 - to sweep and clean clubhouse regularly
 - to maintain a supply of wood for both clubhouse stoves
 - to accept and issue receipts for daily trail fees when at clubhouse
- * Storage shed
 - to maintain in a neat and orderly manner
 - to periodically check club inventory of equipment
- * Ski-doo and J-S
 - to do daily/weekly checks on equipment as will be determined
 - to maintain tracksetters
